13 Lawrence J. Warfield, as the court appointed Receiver, respectfully petitions the Court  
14 as follows:

15 1. On October 28, 2002, this Court entered its *Order Appointing Receiver*, which  
16 appointed Lawrence J. Warfield as Receiver of all of the assets of One Vision Children's  
17 Foundation, Inc. and Wealth Management Resources, Inc. ("Receivership Order").

18 2. Pursuant to *Order Re: Petition No. 1* the Court approved the Receiver's  
19 compensation at the rate of \$150.00 per hour together with all reasonable costs and expenses  
20 incurred relating to these services as Receiver. These services are billed by and paid to the  
21 Receiver's firm, Warfield & Company.

1           3. Pursuant to this Court's Order Re: Petition No. 1, the Receiver has engaged the  
2 services of the law firm of Guttilla & Murphy, PC, of Phoenix, Arizona, and the Receiver has  
3 agreed to pay the law firm compensation at agreed hourly rates for the services of the firm  
4 together with all reasonable costs and expenses incurred on behalf of the Receiver.

5           4. Pursuant to this Court's, the Receiver has engaged the services of the  
6 investigations firm of A & A Investigations, LLC, of Scottsdale, Arizona, and the Receiver  
7 has agreed to pay the investigations firm compensation at agreed hourly rates for the services  
8 of the firm together with all reasonable costs and expenses incurred on behalf of the Receiver.

9           5. Pursuant to the Court's *Order Re: Petition No. 2* the Court authorized the  
10 Receiver and the Law Firm of Guttilla & Murphy, P.C. to file pay petitions without including  
11 as exhibits the itemized statements of services rendered to, and costs incurred or expended on  
12 behalf of, the Receivership, provided that the pay petition includes a statement that anyone  
13 desiring additional information concerning the services and costs to be paid under the pay  
14 petition may obtain such information from the Receiver by delivering to the Receiver and the  
15 Receiver's counsel, Guttilla & Murphy, a written request specifying the additional  
16 information requested at least three days prior to the date set for hearing on the pay petition.  
17 Upon request of the Court, the Receiver shall make available for 'in camera' review by the  
18 Court, the itemized statements and supporting documentation for the services and costs to be  
19 paid under the pay petition.

20           6. The Receiver has submitted itemized statements for services rendered to this  
21 Receivership and for reimbursable costs incurred or paid during the period from June 1, 2004

1 through July 31, 2004. The total amount requested for payment by the Receiver is \$5,230.31.  
2 The Receiver believes that this amount is reasonable and should be paid from the  
3 Receivership Assets.

4 7. The law firm of Guttilla & Murphy, PC, has submitted itemized statements for  
5 services rendered to this Receivership and for reimbursable costs incurred or paid during the  
6 period from June 1, 2004 through July 31, 2004. The total amount requested for payment by  
7 the law firm of Guttilla & Murphy, PC is \$9,283.37. The Receiver believes that this amount  
8 is reasonable and should be paid from the Receivership Assets and has therefore approved  
9 these statements for payment.

10 8. The investigations firm of A & A Investigations, LLC, has submitted an  
11 itemized statement for services rendered to this Receivership and for reimbursable costs  
12 incurred or paid during the period from June 1, 2004 through June 30, 2004. The total  
13 amount requested for payment by the investigations firm of A & A Investigations, LLC is  
14 \$382.50. The Receiver believes that this amount is reasonable and should be paid from the  
15 Receivership Assets and has therefore approved this statement for payment.

16 WHEREFORE, the Receiver respectfully requests that the Court enter an order  
17 authorizing the Receiver to pay from Receivership Assets:


- 18 1. The amount of \$5,230.31 to Warfield & Company for services rendered and

- 20 2. The amount of \$9,283.37 to Guttilla & Murphy, PC, for services rendered and
